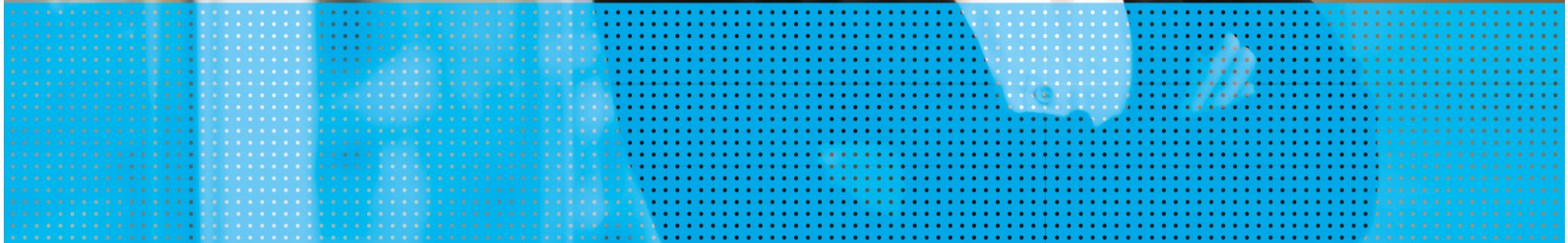

Apply now for the Eppendorf Young Investigator Award 2023

Since 1995 the Eppendorf Award for Young European Investigators is granted annually to researchers up to 35 years, with an advanced degree, for outstanding contributions to biomedical research in Europe based on methods of molecular biology, including novel analytical concepts. The winner is selected by an independent expert committee chaired by Reinhard Jahn (Max Planck Institute for Multidisciplinary Science, Göttingen, Germany).

Selection criteria

- > Independent scientific work
- > Creativity
- > Successful practical application of research approach
- > Significance of research results for the field of medicine
- > Achievement of candidate in relation to his/her age

The 2023 winner receives

- > A prize money of 20,000 EUR
- > Prize ceremony at the EMBL Advanced Training Centre in Heidelberg, Germany, on June 22, 2023
- > Coverage of his/her work by *Nature* (including a podcast)
